QUEENSLAND PREMIER'S AWARDS FOR HEALTH AND MEDICAL RESEARCH 2009

These prestigious Awards which include cash prizes recognise excellence in all areas of health-related research performed in Queensland. The three categories are:

1. Post-graduate Student Award.

- (i) Eligibility - enrolled students and within one year of completing a higher degree. Prizes for the winner (\$3,500) and for two runners-up (\$1,000 each).

2. Post-doctoral Award.

- (ii) Eligibility - between one and five years of completing a higher degree. Prizes for the winner (\$4,500) and for two runners-up (\$1,250 each).

3. Senior Researcher Award.

- (iii) Eligibility - between five and ten years of completing a higher degree. Prizes for the winner (\$5,500) and for two runners-up (\$1,500 each).
