

Guidelines for abstract submission

Abstracts page set up should have a margin of 2.5 cm and be in Times New Roman 12pt font. Scientific Abstract, a complete scientific description of the research (no longer than 3500 characters, **including headings, authors and authors' affiliations**, plain text, no figures) including its significance to health and medicine.

Lay Abstract should be a **short** paragraph (no longer than **2000 characters, including headings, authors and authors' affiliations**, plain text, no figures) explaining the research and its significance in non-technical language.

ABSTRACT TITLE, AUTHORS' NAMES AND AFFILIATIONS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING FORMAT:

Title: in **CAPITALS, BOLD, CENTER ALIGNMENT**

Authors: include First name (initials) and Surname of all authors and underline the presenting author.

Authors' affiliations: in *Italics*. List the authors' affiliations referring to authors with *super script numbers*.

Body text: Sentence case.
